

ACADEMIC ADVISING



- Faculty members serve as academic advisors.
- **First-year advisors represent all disciplines.** They may teach a course in which the student is enrolled, be an athletic liaison to the student's sport, teach in the student's academic area of interest, or they may simply enjoy advising first-year students.
- It is not necessary that the first-year advisor is in the student's major.
- Students may stay with their original academic advisor for the entire time at BSC, or they may change advisors at any time. Having a good working relationship with your advisor is key.
- Students are required to meet with their academic advisor at least once a term. Students will not be able to register without advisor approval.
- It is recommended that students keep in regular contact with their advisor.
