First act

Second act

Third act

Jacob starts crying so much about Joseph and what happened to him. The goal now is to get Joseph back to his dad, but Jacob can do nothing about it since his sons did not tell him the truth.

Plot point 1

The nomads take Joseph to Egypt and sell him there to the king of Egypt. The second highest king of Egypt and his wife take care of him and raise him until he is thirty years old. Joseph is the most handsome human God ever created. The second highest king's wife (become antagonist for a period) falls in love with him and demands him to have intercourse with her; he refuses, then she lies that he tried to rape her and puts him in jail for 12 years. After twelve years, the

highest king of Egypt dreams of seeing seven quail cows next to the Nile River, and then these seven quail cows get eaten by seven skinny cows. No one could interpret the highest king's dream. The highest king sends few people to release Joseph.

Plot point 2
